STORK

VALLEY DEVELOPMENT

A new T-bar has been erected on the far side of the 'Chair' in the Perisher Gap area. It extends nearly to the top station of the Chairlift and will open up a considerable area of good skiable snow without the necessity of that long traverse back to the bottom station. A Mr Droga, formerly of Thredbo, has been appointed as Manager for the Perisher Valley Hotels and ski area. The Company intends to employ 5 professional ski Patrollers this season and the volunteer body, Perisher Ski Patrol Association, have introduced stringent training and patrolling regulations to improve their own efficiency.

Day parking in the area near No. 1 terminal is expected to cost \$3 this season, and there is a plan to establish a child minding centre in the Community Centre (Church) near the Ski Centre.

A considerable amount of grooming has been carried out in the area between No. 1 and the Duplex T-bars, rocks and other obstacles have been cleared and drainage pipes laid to reduce the quagmire that always develops at the bottom of this slope. All lifts have been given names relating to Australian explorers, the new lift for instance is named 'Mawson' others are 'Burke', 'Wills' etc., etc.

Day tickets are expected to cost \$6.50 with half days available both morning and afternoon for \$4. A child's day ticket should cost \$4 also. There is also the possibility that 6-day tickets will be available for \$32 from Sunday to Friday inclusive or Monday to Saturday.
